Precautions for Summer 2020
in compliance with State of NC and the CDC recommendations
Updated May 25, 2020

Per [CDC guidelines](#), if a student or staff member has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or is presumed positive by a medical professional due to symptoms, they will be excluded from activities at our studio until:

- No fever for at least 72 hours since recovery (without the use of fever-reducing medicine)
- Other symptoms have improved (e.g., coughing, shortness of breath) AND
- At least 10 days have passed since first symptoms

Per [CDC guidelines](#), if a student or staff member has been diagnosed with COVID-19 but does not have symptoms, they will not be allowed at our studio until 10 days have passed since the date of their first positive COVID-19 diagnostic test, assuming they have not subsequently developed symptoms since their positive test.

If a student or staff member shows any of the following symptoms for COVID-19, they will not be allowed to enter or will be asked to leave the studio immediately.

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fever
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell

All students and staff will sign a **Safety First Partnership Agreement** and will verbally confirm each time that they have entered the studio that the information is still accurate.

- Students who develop symptoms at any time while at our studio will be separated immediately and be picked up as soon as possible.
- Designated isolation area for sick workers or campers.
- Training of coaches / camp counselors how to identify symptoms, process for removing a potentially ill student, and infection mitigation procedures to perform if that happens.

Check-in and Check-out

- Arrive at least **10 minutes** prior to your class start time to complete the Safety First Partnership Agreement, hand sanitization and temperature check with the Front Desk Staff.
- Students and parents waiting must maintain a minimum 6 feet apart, or in their car.
- Each student will come to the Front Desk Staff 1 at a time, and have their temperature taken (forehead thermometer).
- If all readings are normal, the student may enter the building. 99 or above temperature, the student will return to their parent/legal guardian at the car.
- Parents must wait in their vehicles until their student is inside the building before leaving.
- Front Desk Staff will remain outside the building until 5 minutes after the hour.
- All students must be picked up on time from their classes / camps at our back entrance.

Facility

- Water fountains will be out of service this summer; water bottles only allowed at the studio. Students can ask a teacher or staff member to refill their water bottle.
- Signs posted around the facility of updated sanitation procedures (only touch your stuff, wash your hands, don't touch your face, etc.)
- Hand sanitizing stations designated around the gym.
- Scheduled disinfection of equipment before and after use, even between classes.
- Teachers will enforce social distancing and prohibit congregating of groups.
- Students should leave immediately after training; no loitering.
- Additional scheduled cleaning of high-touch surfaces: doorknobs, light switches, handles, etc throughout hours of operation.
- All bathrooms will be sanitized between camp and classes, and again after classes are over; no less than twice per day.
- Designated "Coaches Only and Men's" bathroom.
- Practice social distancing (6' or more) between everyone at all times.
- Teachers will eliminate any aerobic exercises.
- State mandate: Limit groups to 10 or less (including students and coaches) in an indoor space
- We will keep groups of students together.
 - All equipment will be sanitized after each use.
- Require each student to wash or sanitize hands after each group restroom break, meal break, snack break.
- Campers must be self sufficient at lunchtime. Make sure campers can open their own lunch items. Staff will not open snack bags, Tupperware, drinks, etc.

Face Mask Policy

- **Face Masks** are to be worn at all times while in our studio. The face mask can come off temporarily if the person is having trouble breathing or it is causing other safety hazard. [CDC Guidelines](#)
